Send your students to GPS@UFS and set them up for **success**.


GPS@UFS (Graduation Positioning Support) which consists of three large-scaled projects: Digital Skills and Competency, Track your Success, and Career Development and Employability was conceptualised by the Centre for Teaching and Learning (CTL) and Career Services, with inputs from institutional stakeholders and generous donor support. GPS@UFS aims to equip students with essential digital skills, academic support, and career readiness tools for success in their studies, as well as their transition to employment.

The Digital Skills and Competencies Pathway has been designed to help students develop the digital skills that will assist them in being successful in their studies and boost their employability as it is based on the competencies required in the workforce. In this pathway, students acquire skills across four themes: ICT Proficiency, Digital Citizenship, Information, Data and Media Literacy, and Digital Creation. These themes are scaffolded across three levels of competence, and students can achieve a certificate by completing guizzes for each level.

**Track your Success** aims to minimise students' time to graduate, optimise support and offer equitable opportunities to succeed. At-risk undergraduate students are identified through predictive analytics and nudged to appropriate just-in-time support via trained and dedicated success coaches and a more comprehensive student support network.

The **Career Development and Employability** Pathway aims to get students employed by following five easy steps from first to final year. The pathway will teach students how to craft an industry-ready CV and LinkedIn profile, while having confidence to network and market themselves. They will also be enabled to align applications with industry requirements and promote themselves well during interviews.
