



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS: UFS SECOND-YEAR STRUCTURED MASTERS BURSARIES 2023

The University of the Free State will be providing financial support (partial tuition fee) to second-year structured master's students for the year 2023.

Who can apply?

- Second-year structured master's students registered for the mini-dissertation.

Who is not eligible?

- Students registered for an MBA degree.

Important to note?

- The bursary is a once-off award for the 2023 academic year; there is no guarantee for 2024 funding.
- Only students who do not have any other source of funding will be considered. Students who are recipients of other tuition fee funding in 2023 do not qualify.
- Students must meet all academic requirements of the university and be registered for a master's degree with a research component (mini-dissertation) at the University of the Free State.
- Students must already have an internal UFS supervisor assigned.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- UFS Master's Bursary holders must attend the Centre for Graduate Support Research Capacity Development workshops.

What is covered?

- Partial tuition fees, which will be subject to the availability of funds.

What is not covered?

- University registration fees, accommodation fees and living costs.
