

## MASTER'S AND DOCTORAL DEGREE SUBMISSION GUIDELINE OF DISSERTATIONS AND THESES

## Assessment of master's degree research dissertation or interrelated, publishable manuscripts/ published articles and doctoral thesis or interrelated, publishable manuscripts/ published articles.

A student who is **ready to submit** their research in terms of a master's or doctoral degree for assessment must – with the approval of the supervisor and, if applicable, the cosupervisor(s)– submit an electronic copy (word or pdf) of their research and the supporting documents to the relevant **Faculty Postgraduate Coordinator** who will verify the documents and forward them to the official at the Centre for Graduate Support (CGS), or the Student Administration offices in the case of students in the Faculty of Health Sciences. **The submission deadline date for the 2025 December graduations** is **31 July 2025**.

**NB:** The following supporting documents should accompany the research submission:

- Title page (as per the guidelines set in the general academic rules)
- Signed declaration by the student (per the guidelines set in the general academic rules).
- Certified copy of ID.
- Turnitin summary report
- A signed declaration by the supervisor (per the guidelines set in the general academic rules).
