The CAGE code provides a standardised method of identifying a given facility at a specific location.  CAGE codes are used internationally as part of the NATO Codification System (NCS), where they are sometimes called NCAGE codes.

Through the FWA, an institution commits to complying with the requirements in the US Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) Protection of Human Subjects regulations at 45 CFR part 46. Content created by the Office for Human Research Protections.
