The Joint Call for Research Projects on Tuberculosis is now open; only proposals with co-principal investigators from both South Africa and France will be eligible for funding. To support collaboration, a matchmaking platform is offered where researchers from South Africa and France can connect. This joint call seeks to support research and innovation projects that cover the full spectrum of TB disease, including subclinical and drug-resistant TB. Research proposals are invited to address the following major topics in both adults and children:

- I. Epidemiology, pathogenesis, transmission, and management of sub-clinical TB.
- II. Identification of biomarkers for disease progression and the development of novel diagnostics based on this.
- III. Development of rapid diagnostic tools for evaluating drug resistance and for precision medicine in the management of TB.
- IV. Development of new vaccine strategies, including new candidates to fill the vaccine development pipeline and strategies for feasibility and implementation of new vaccines coming onto the market.
- V. Evaluation of new drugs or shortened regimens, especially for paediatric populations.
