

Spencer research grants for education

The Small Research Grants on Education Programme supports education research projects that will contribute to the improvement of education – broadly conceived – with budgets up to \$50 000 for projects ranging from one to five years. This programme is ‘field-initiated’, in that proposal submissions are not in response to a specific request for a particular research topic, discipline, design, method, or location.

Annexures to be uploaded:

1. Project timeline – A project timeline should be uploaded as a PDF file and should indicate the proposed start and end dates of the project as well as key project events and milestones.

The major activities listed in the project timeline should be reflected in the proposal narrative.

2. A letter of support from the scholar's dean should be uploaded as a PDF file. The supporting letter must include

- (a) confirmation that the scholar's course load is six courses or more per academic year;
- (b) confirmation that the scholar will be released from teaching a course if awarded the supplemental funds; and
- (c) confirmation that the budgeted amount for the course release is appropriate for their institution.

Signature from authorised representative of the administering organisation:

This section of the application details the steps necessary to obtain the authorised signature for your proposal through the Adobe e-sign process.

You, as the applicant, are responsible for making sure that your proposal is signed by the deadline. We recommend filling in the online application at least a week ahead of the deadline.
