Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

SDG 1: No Poverty

 - → The Chair promotes circular economy practices in animal product processing and waste minimisation.

 - → The Chair fosters low-emission livestock innovations and adaptation strategies.

 - → Sustainable grazing and land-use practices reduce degradation and enhance ecosystem resilience.

 - → The Chair convenes academia, government, industry, and farmers for joint action.
