### **Duration of fellowship:**

Three to nine months research stay at a research laboratory in another <a href="ICGEB">ICGEB</a> member state

# Required documents:

- Applicant's full CV
- CV of the head of the receiving laboratory (include publication list)
- Valid passport or ID

Two referees must submit confidential letters directly through the system.

Applications must include endorsements from both home and host institutions.

Final ICGEB closing date: Submit application via the ICGEB online portal – 30 September 2025

#### Eligibility criteria:

- Be nationals of an ICGEB member state.
- Be early-career researchers registered for a PhD or have completed a PhD within the past five years and be actively working in a research institution.
- MSc holders may apply if they are engaged in research.
- Mobility must be between two different ICGEB member states.
- The fellowship does not support participation in workshops, conferences, or bridging fellowships.
- While there is no age limit, preference is given to young scientists at the start of their careers.
