With a total budget of €120 million – including contributions from the EU's Horizon Europe programme (€57 million), IHI industry members (€48 million), and IHI contributing partners (€15 million) – this two-stage call supports cutting-edge research to improve patient outcomes across Europe.

- Topic 4: Leveraging Europe's expertise to accelerate cell therapy for type 1 diabetes
- Topic 5: Establishing ortho and cardiology ambulatory surgical centres in Europe
