

MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships

The <u>Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MCSA) Postdoctoral Fellowships</u> offer the perfect fellowship opportunities for researchers who submit a joint application with a host organisation in either the academic or non-academic sector to conduct research.

The webinar, which will be held on **22 April 2025 from 13:00 CET**, will further explain the opportunities provided in terms of hosting offers, but also in terms of training for the candidates. *Kindly familiarise yourself with the attached document, which guides you in six steps on how to prepare your application.*

Postdoctoral fellowships can take place in Europe (within an EU member state or a Horizon Europe-associated country) or in a non-associated third country.

- European Postdoctoral Fellowships are open to researchers of any nationality who wish to conduct research and innovation (R&I) projects in Europe, either by relocating from another country or moving within Europe. The standard fellowship duration ranges from 12 to 24 months.
- **Global Postdoctoral Fellowships** are designed for European nationals or long-term residents who want to work on R&I projects with organisations outside the EU and Horizon Europe-associated countries. These fellowships require an outgoing phase of at least 12 and up to 24 months in a non-associated third country, followed by a mandatory 12-month return phase to a host organisation in an EU member state or a Horizon Europe-associated country.

Specific eligibility requirements apply to MSCA postdoctoral fellowships in research areas covered by the Euratom Research and Training Programme 2021-2025.

8 May 2025 – Call for proposals opens 10 September 2025 – Proposal submission deadline
