## Letters of recommendation

Three (3) reference letters to be uploaded directly on the application portal by your referees.

Referees must be familiar with the applicant's current work and study plans and be well placed to attest to the candidate's academic achievements.

Please note that your application cannot be considered until at least two referees have completed their reference forms. Please follow up directly with your referees before the submission closing date.

Closing date for institutional budget approval: 11 August 2025 @Sugandren Moodley and @Zusake

Budget/s: Candidates are encouraged to be realistic with their costs, as budget

amendments are not permitted after an award has been granted.

**OMT:** Final closing date: 28 August 2025, but you are advised to submit at least 48 hours prior to the final closing date.
