- 1. **Sample:** The LSSE-SASSE Combined report shows responses from both students and lecturers at your institution who completed SASSE and LSSE. This report contains responses from lecturers who responded to the survey based on their experiences of teaching either first-year or senior modules/subjects. Data from lecturers who responded based on another type of module/subject or who did not report a class level are not included in this report.
- 2. Class level: Frequency distributions are reported separately for lecturers who teach mostly first-year or senior modules. Student responses are also reported separately for first-year and senior students.
- 3. Item numbers: Item numbering corresponds to the survey facsimiles included in your Institutional Report.
- 4. Item wording and variable names: Item wording as it appears on the SASSE instrument. The second column in each box contains the name of each SASSE variable and then the corresponding LSSE variable for easy reference to your SASSE and LSSE data files.
- 5. Response options: The percentage of students who selected the corresponding response option are listed just as they appear on the SASSE instrument.
