Matriculated at St. Andrews School, Bloemfontein in 1963. Graduated BA Natal University 1968. B.A. (Hons) University of the Orange Free State 1970. Post Graduate Certificate in Education London University 1972. Master of Arts University of the Orange Free State, on a thesis entitled "Banda, Malawi and South Africa - A Contemporary Study".

In addition to the above academic qualification, he is a member of the Public Relations Institute of South Africa as well as being a member of the Institute of Personnel Management of S.A. In 1968 he was awarded the Abe Bailey Travel Scholarship to the United Kingdom and in 1972/73 studied in London under an Anglo American Scholarship.

3. THE DOCUMENTS AND THEIR ARRANGEMENT

3.1 The collection was handed over to the Institute for Contemporary History by Mr. Crawford in several instalments, during the period 1975 - 1983.

3.2 ARRANGEMENT

The collection consists of unnumbered subject files in connection with Malawi. A subject classification is therefore maintained with an indication of the kind of material which can be found in each file.

To assist the researcher, series are divided into sub-series.

1. Institute for Contemporary History: IG 5/2 R.D. Crawford

In all cases documents were arranged chronologically and undated papers were placed at the end of a file.

Various publications not part of the subject files, are indicated in appendices A - E. In all cases these publications are supplementary to the subject files and contain notes and indications of topics. Consequently these publications are left intact in the collection.

4. EXTENT AND CONDITION

This collection is in a very good state of preservation and occupies 0,50m shelving space.
