Pers, 1924-1925); Assistent Redakteur van "The Natal Mercury" (1925-1934);
Rubriekskrywer van "The man on the spot", (Cape Times, 1934-1965) tot
aftrede.

Hy was ook na sy aftrede stigtersdirekteur van "Historiese Huise",
Stellenbosch.

¹⁾Omtrent hierdie werk skryf die skrywer: "The manuscript of This is my Country was written in Cape Town - London in 1952 -1953 and rejected in that pre-Republic period by all London agents and publishers to whom it was submitted. It is, of course, considerably dated in this year of 1968. It was written at a time when a flood of anti-South African books were reaching the market along with venomous newspaper criticism of Dr Malan and apartheid and endeavoured to be an answer to them.

Such textual amendments as appear in it were made at the time."
