Donald Bell Sole was born in Grahamstown on the 13th December 1917. He attended Kingswood College and Rhodes University College. His BA results produced a double first and a bursary to enable him to take his Master's degree in History.

On April 1, 1938 he reported for duty in Pretoria as Probationer Diplomat at the Department of External Affairs.

Ambassador to the United States of America until 1982 and formerly Ambassador to the Federal Republic of Germany. Under - Secretary and subsequently Deputy Secretary of the Department of Foreign Affairs, 1962 to 1968. SA Minister in Vienna, Austria, 1958 to 1961. Chairman of the Board of Governor's, International Atomic Energy Agency, 1959 - 1960. SA Permanent Representative to the United Nations, 1956 to 1957.
