

Attention UFS Senior student,

So you've checked your PeopleSoft and suddenly there are a few new things you do not understand.

As of the 2021 academic year, the UFS have instituted a process of categorising/determining our students' academic standing. This process enables you as a UFS student to understand your academic standing in relation to your academic performance and progression. All our senior students' academic records have been reviewed and based on the 2020 academic performance across the faculties an indicator put up on your Academic Data Summary (ADS). Now here is what it all means:



Academic standing colour	ADS Service Indicator	Status	What to do... (action)
Green	Positive	Excellent	You are on track! You have passed all your 2020 modules and may proceed to register online. Should you however have additional queries, you are welcome to contact the advisors.
Yellow 1 (Y1) Yellow 2 (Y2)	Positive	On track	Y1: You did not pass all your modules but you are still on track. Proceed to register online but register the modules you failed first. Y2: You changed academic programmes (i.e. completed a DV2 form previously). Check your record that the relevant credits/recognitions reflect. Proceed to register online
Orange	Negative	Priority	You cannot continue with online registration without having a conversation with your faculty academic advisor. Please contact for support. If you need to change programmes and are uncertain what to change to, contact the CTL general/central academic advisor.
Red	Negative	High Priority	Did you receive communication from the faculty? Did you submit your appeal? You cannot proceed to register unless granted permission by the faculty. Check your ufs4life inbox for all communication.

Note: In some instances, faculties have categorised students using other colours, (i.e. grey, purple etc.). Please contact your faculty/department for advice, your status has not yet been finalised.
