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

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To track your UFS application status on the UFS system: Open any internet browser and type **www.ufs.ac.za** in the URL.




On the active page of the UFS website: Click on the **'Students'** tab to navigate to KovsieLife.




Click the **'Student Self Service'** tab on the active KovsieLife webpage.



After clicking on **'Student Self-Service'**, you will be navigated to the **'ICT Support for Students'** page. Click on **'Self-Service'**.





After clicking on **'Self-Service'**, you will need to click on **'Student Self-Service'** to be navigated to the Oracle PeopleSoft system/login page.




PeopleSoft system:
