Welcome to Student Leadership Development

We strive to meet student leaders' capacity-building needs and develop their full potential.

The Office for Student Leadership Development (SLD) provides channels for student pathways and signature development while creating opportunities to enter leadership positions and pursue career development.

THE SLD OFFICE PURPOSE:

- Provide a formal and institutionally integrated co-curriculum
- Research on graduate leadership development
- Design leadership programmes delivered through student-life colleges and communities in collaboration with faculties and other departments.

ABOUT OUR PROGRAMMES:

We offer students a variety of programmes, presented face-to-face, online, or as hybrid sessions. Open to all undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate students, these programmes promote holistic development and enhance students' academic performance and social integration.

Our programmes align with two overarching themes, **Leadership Development Programmes** and **Leadership Training Programmes**, each consisting of two pillars.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES

• **FutureLEAD: Essential/Critical Leadership Development**

The FutureLEAD Leadership Development Challenge (FLC) is an online learning programme over four to seven months, engaging students on Blackboard and in forum discussions on and around understanding and using leadership in various situations and environments (studies, personal, community, and career).

• **AdvanceLEAD: Advanced/Specialised Leadership Development**

The AdvanceLEAD Leadership Development Challenge (ALC) is a selective leadership programme for high-achieving student leaders with potential. They undergo specialised training, and are channeled to advanced leadership development programmes and virtual exchange opportunities, e.g., participation in national and international symposiums, leadership courses, summits and seminars.

LEADERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAMMES

• **KovsieLEAD: Student Governance Training**

This component includes training of elected student governance structures and committees across campuses to be fully equipped and functional. The institutional induction training of student governance structures and operational and portfolio-specific training, e.g. executive committees of the CSRCs, RCs, associations and organisations, and faculty councils' office bearers, refer.

• **PurposeLEAD: Ad hoc/ Specific Training**

Purposeful training, aligned with institutional goals or preparing and mobilising students and governance structures to support their specific needs, events, and campaigns, applies here. The pre-election candidate training, accessibility and diversity training, and a series of quarterly sessions on 'What Students Should Know' (WSSK) about human rights, gender-based violence, sustainable development, global citizenship, etc., can be mentioned.

Goal: Advanced development/exposure
