There are various funding opportunities available to you – you just need to know where to look and apply. Funding comprises scholarships, bursaries, and loans. There are financial aid options available through Funza Lushaka for Education students, as well as NSFAS funding for a variety of programmes. Bursaries are also available that are generally awarded based on academic merit.

In the year preceding your studies, apply as soon as possible for various bursaries that will cover your study programme. Irrespective of your admittance to study, do not wait to apply. Make sure that you meet the criteria of the bursar, apply in time, and provide all the relevant supporting documents. Do not assume that the bursary will be awarded to you.


REMEMBER: Incomplete applications will not be processed and will thus not be considered.

Always have clear copies of the following

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

to submit with your different funding applications:

- ✓ Identity document (certified copy)
- ✓ Grade 11 results
- June matric results, if currently in matric (certified copy)
- Matric certificate, if matric is completed (certified copy)
- Proof of registration or provisional acceptance
- ✓ Awards/certificates obtained, where applicable
- Letter of recommendation from teacher/mentor/peer
- Two references (with contact details)
- Proof of work completed in your chosen field of study
- Identity documents of parents/guardian (certified copies)
- Proof of residence
- National Benchmark Test results (certified copy)
- Pay slip or affidavit

Apply for the funding of your choice. Make sure that you add all the supporting documents. **REMEMBER to press submit.**
