

GENERAL MINIMUM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- A National Senior Certificate (NSC) or National Certificate: Vocational (NCV) Level 4, and an AP of 18.
- Four subjects on Level 3 (40%–49%).
- Language of instruction on Level 3 (40%) for all options.

FACULTY-SPECIFIC ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Economic and Management Sciences:

- Commerce route study option.
- Administration route study option.


