THE SCHOOL OF CLINICAL MEDICINE, SCHOOL OF PATHOLOGY AND SCHOOL OF BIOMEDICAL SCIENCES

In the School of Clinical Medicine, School of Pathology and School of Biomedical Sciences, we offer degrees that will open doors for you as a medical doctor or a medical physicist. You need at least a minimum AP score of 36 and at least 60% in each of Mathematics, Life Sciences and Physical Sciences to qualify to be selected. Keep in mind that although you may qualify to be selected there is no guarantee that you will be selected as there are limited spaces available. The closing date for applications is every year on 31 May.



SCHOOL FOR HEALTH AND REHABILITATION SCIENCES

The School for Health and Rehabilitation Sciences has an exciting range of qualifications available. If you dream of being a physiotherapist, optometrist, occupational therapist, dietician, biokineticist or sport coaching professional – then this is the place for you. Remember that admission to all these programmes is subject to selection and applications close every year on 31 May.



SPORT COACHING

For the Sport Coaching qualification, a minimum AP score of 30 is required as well as a minimum of 50% in the language of learning.



OPTOMETRY

For the B Optom qualification to study Optometry, the minimum requirements are an AP score of 33, as well as 60% in the language of learning, life sciences and physical sciences. For Mathematics a minimum of 50% is needed.



PHYSIOTHERAPY, DIETETICS, AND OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

For Physiotherapy, Dietetics, and Occupational Therapy, the minimum requirements are an AP score of 33, with the language of learning and life sciences at 60% and mathematics and physical sciences at a minimum of 50%.



BIOKINETICS

For the Biokinetics programme, the minimum requirements are an AP score of 33, with the language of learning at 60% and mathematics, life sciences and physical sciences respectively at 50%.



SCHOOL OF NURSING

The School of Nursing offers a very special Nursing qualification. To qualify, your AP must be at least 30, the language of learning at 50%; either mathematics at 40% or mathematical literacy at 70% will be accepted, as well as either life sciences at 60% or physical sciences at 50%. Applications close on 31 July. Make sure you meet the minimum admission requirements before you apply, as admission is also subject to selection.
