TIP₁

Start by doing an online quotation based on the programme/modules you plan to enrol for. For the estimated costs/quotation, visit www.ufs.ac.za and follow the links: Students – Student Finance – Quotation.



TIP 2

Budget for other expenses such as registration, breakage fee if you are selected to stay in a campus residence, private accommodation if you stay off campus, textbooks, study material, pocket money, food, data, travelling, clothes, and any other expense you might need to consider.



TIP 3

If you need financial assistance, apply for funding to help pay your fees early so that you are not stressed, and can secure your financial assistance ahead of registration.
