Four – six weeks of guided training provided by leading experts within the iKudu consortium.

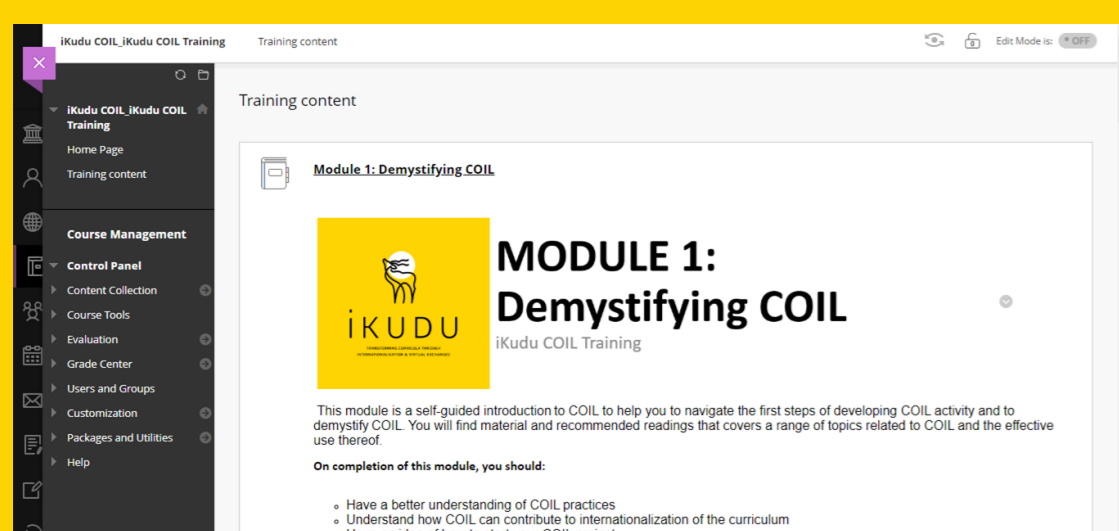


COIL Foundation Course

The COIL foundation course will help you strengthen the connection between IoC and why we develop COIL. It will provide the necessary context to strengthen COIL understanding and COIL design.

Professional Development Series

Once you have been partnered, you will be invited to attend a four-session professional development series.



- Session 1:** COIL in the IoC landscape and Demystifying COIL
- Session 2:** Learning outcomes and Intercultural learning
- Session 3:** Collaborative tasks and Educational technology
- Session 4:** Reflection and assessment for COIL and Implementation.

This professional development consists of six self-paced modules designed to introduce you to the fundamentals of COIL, and to prepare you and your partner for the implementation of your joint COIL project.

- Module 1:** Demystifying COIL
- Module 2:** Planning for your COIL and Introduction to Intercultural Competences
- Module 3:** Crafting your COIL - Internationalised Learning Outcomes
- Module 4:** Crafting your Collaborative Tasks – Motivation, Class Size Management and Technology
- Module 5:** Reflection and Assessment
- Module 6:** Decolonisation

Complete a COIL project plan (PDF image attached) During the professional development, you and your partner will be given a COIL project plan to complete. This document will help you and your partner plan your joint COIL project within your existing curricula.

The interesting part of COIL is that you and your partner are not required to redesign a new course altogether. Instead, both of you will find a complementary component within your existing curricula.

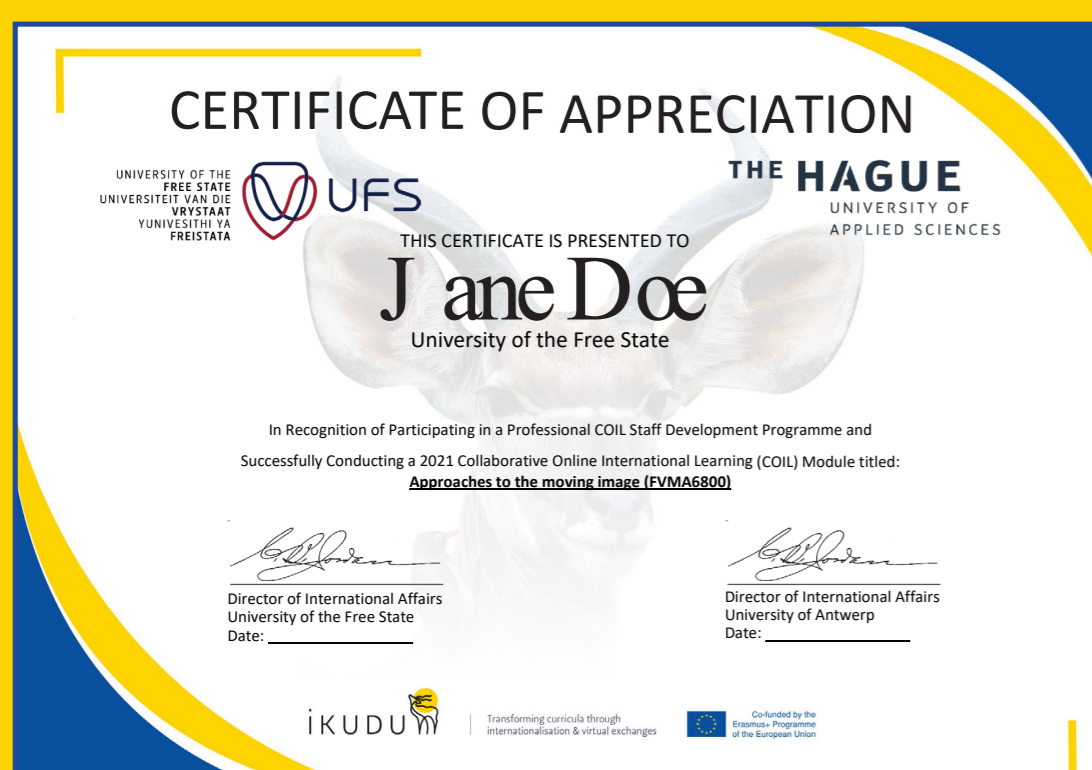
In doing so, you will be able to infuse an international dimension into your existing curricula.

Certificates



Once you have completed your COIL project, you can request a student and/or academic certificate from your university liaison officer. These certificates are not compulsory, but we do encourage academics to issue these certificates to students in recognition of their participation in a COIL course. Students, of course, can later include these certificates in their CVs to enhance their employability. With the academic certificate, we acknowledge their efforts to develop a collaborative task and facilitate intercultural learning.
