- Align research focus with the changing direction and expectations of the UFS.
- Encourage initiating, developing and implementing tangible research projects and become research leaders.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

The programme reserves the right to nominate mid-career academic women, 40 years and older, to participate in the programme and to invite them to a panel interview in which their personal qualities, professional commitment and academic ambition will be evaluated. Participation in the programme is voluntary and open to all permanently employed mid-career academic women at the UFS. Participants will be required to:

- Commit to active participation once invited.
- Set aside time for scholarly engagement.
- Have a willingness to lead a substantial and innovative research programme.
- Make a contribution to their area of research.
