

## Access to the University of the Free State

Access to the university premises is restricted to the main gate situated at **205 Nelson Mandela Drive, Park West, Bloemfontein, 9301** and the visitors gate, gate five, situated at **DF Malherbe Drive, Park West, Bloemfontein, 9301**.

## Air Travel

The majority of international airlines are extending their services to South Africa, with prevalent direct routes leading to either OR Tambo International Airport in Johannesburg or Cape Town International Airport. However, only specific airlines offer services to the **Bram Fischer International Airport in Bloemfontein.**



## Bus Travel

As an alternative and cost-effective mode of transportation, one may consider using the bus or shuttle system. However, it is imperative to note that the preferred choice for travel remains air transport, as this is faster and will reduce time spent on the road.



# TIPS AND TRICKS TO NAVIGATE SOUTH AFRICA



## Language

01

The predominant languages in the city (depending on ethnicity) are **Afrikaans · English · Sesotho**.

However, the vast majority of citizens comprehend most of these languages, even if it is not their first language.



## Weather

The temperatures in Bloemfontein can vary from mild to quite cold in **May, as autumn usually turns into winter during the first two weeks**.

Maximum temperatures vary **between 9°C and 20°C**. Layered clothes are a must. Please check the weather forecast closer to the time.



## Electricity

- While Bloemfontein generally experiences a constant electricity supply, it is crucial to note that the entire country occasionally faces pressure on its power grid, leading to frequent load shedding and potential daily power outages. As a precautionary measure, it is advisable to keep a flashlight, battery-operated lights, or candles in your room.
- The standard electrical supply is 220/230 volts AC at 50 Hz.
- Plugs commonly found are 15 amp three-prong or 5 amp two-prong with round pins.
- US-made appliances may need a transformer.
- Most hotel rooms are equipped with 110-volt outlets for electric shavers and appliances.

## Banking facilities

In South Africa, the majority of major credit cards, such as **Mastercard and Visa**, are widely accepted. As the **ZAR (Rand)** is the official currency, it is recommended to convert your currency if you intend to make cash payments or want to 'tip' the waiter, porter, etc.

**All major banks** are conveniently positioned **within walking distance of campus**, and on-campus automated teller machines (ATMs) are available.

**Please take note of the following safety tips when using an ATM:**

- Whenever possible, opt for ATMs that you are familiar with or select those situated in well-lit and secure locations.
- Before approaching the ATM, carefully scan the surrounding area, and refrain from using the ATM if there are suspicious individuals nearby or if the location seems isolated or unsafe.

**For exchanging traveller's cheques or foreign currency**, it is necessary to have your passport on hand.

Please note that foreign currency and traveller's cheques can only be **exchanged at Travelex located at Mimosa Mall**.
