STEP 2 | START YOUR REGISTRATION TASK | PART 1

ENROL (REGISTER) AND FOLLOW THE STEPS

Online registrations open on 2 January 2026. You should submit your registration request online by completing the Registration Activity Guide.

STEP 2 | NEED TO CLEAR YOUR HOLDS? | PART 2

FINANCE HOLD

Make sure that your first payment is made at least five (5) working days before registration. If you have an approved bursary/sponsorship that covers your fees for 2026, please submit your confirmation letter to tuitionfees@ufs.ac.za as soon as possible.

For NSFAS-approved students – once NSFAS has confirmed your funding, you will receive an SMS indicating when the prepayment block is lifted. If you do not receive this SMS within two (2) weeks of NSFAS confirming your funding, or before your curriculum advising session, please contact the UFS Financial Aid Office for support.

You should still be able to start your registration request via the online platform, even if you have not yet made the first payment. Your registration will only be final once all requirements have been met:

- No outstanding fees on your student account.
- Proof of funding or the first payment has been submitted. Click on the link for more information on first payments:

- No academic hold.

If your registration request cannot be processed by the deadline due to any outstanding documents or payments, your registration will remain incomplete.


